Please note that you must register with us within 14 days of taking up residency. To register in our commune, we require the following documents from you or for the person to be registered:

- When registering underage children, the custody decision or declaration of consent of the other parent must be brought along.
- If you are moving to Switzerland from abroad, you must submit proof of taking out Swiss health insurance or exemption from compulsory health insurance in Switzerland within 90 days of arrival.
